The number of 14-24 year olds who currently vape has skyrocketed since 2020. To protect young people from the harms of vapes, Cancer Council WA has created a new vaping prevention campaign, 'Clear the Air' with the support of Healthway.

The first digital advertisements from the Clear the Air campaign, <u>Rotten Fruit</u>, unveil the rotten truth about vapes that are hidden behind deceptively innocent flavours. The advertisements encourage people to visit the Clear the Air website for more facts about the chemicals, heath harms and addictiveness of vaping, and ways to quit.

This digital campaign is running from 29 October 2023 to 30 June 2024 across Instagram, Facebook, Snapchat, TikTok, Twitch, YouTube, ondemand streaming services and mobile apps. Please do not share on social media after 30 June 2024
