 - Low strength alcohol and non alcoholic choices must be available, should alcohol be available at the activity or event,
 - No activities or promotions that encourage rapid consumption of alcohol (e.g. discounted rink prices, happy hours, drinking competitions) should alcohol be available at activities or events,
 - Alcoholic drinks should be served in standard size drink portions, if alcohol is available at activities or events, and
 - No promotions or event names that glamorise getting drunk or imply that getting drunk is desirable e.g. providing drinks or cocktails with names that imply they will get you drunk

To submit a final Acquittal to Western Australian Schools Canteen Association (WASCA) within six months of the closing date for applications, including:

- Completed evaluation form,
- Copy of media, pictures, photographs
- Receipts showing expenditure as per approved funding
- Certificates for all club members who completed Fuel to Go Play training
- Inclusion of menu, pre and post partnership
